# TERRY FOX

In 1977, 18 year old Terry Fox was diagnosed with a bone cancer called osteogenic sarcoma and had his right knee amputated. Feeling the need to make a change in the lives of other cancer patients, he began the Marathon of Hope in 1980 and ran across Canada, fundraising money for cancer research. After 140 days and 5373 kilometres of running, he was forced to stop running because cancer had spread to his lungs. On June 28th, 1981, Terry passed away. Since then, his legacy has continued on and every year across Canada, Terry Fox Runs are hosted and have raised over \$850 million in support of cancer research.

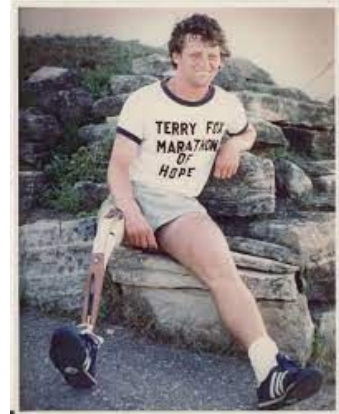
On September 23rd, Banting will be hosting our annual Terry Fox Run.

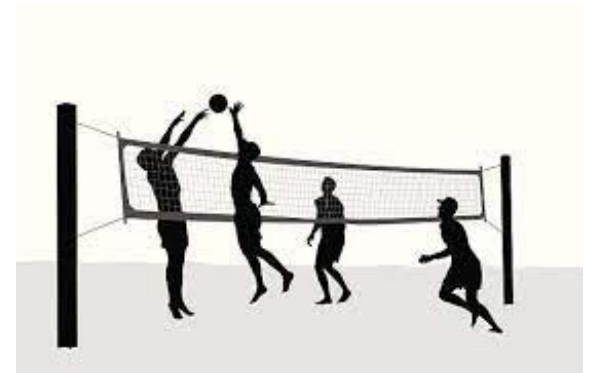
