
Hey Banting,




Open mic is taking place this Friday April 19th in the caf at lunch. All of the performance spots have been filled for this open mic.

Banting's Military Co-op

Have you EVER thought about joining the Military?? Did you know you can join the military thru Banting's Co-op Program?

This is a Full-Time Co-op, offered during the 2nd Semester.

You would:

- Earn 4 High School Credits.
- Make \$14,000 under the Paid Co-op.
- Be given an option to continue working full-time for the remaining 2+ months of Summer earning an additional \$10,000
- Get all your military qualifications and be fully trained in your choice of occupation. *Some restrictions.
- Remain in the Reserves (after Co-op) in a Part-time capacity and be offered full-time employment each summer.

There will be an information session on **<u>April 30th During period 2.</u>**

Interested students should sign up in the co-op office or on class D2L if they would like to attend.
