Yesterday, Banting hosted the Senior Regional Badminton tournament. Thank you to all players and volunteers for representing Banting and helping the tournament be a success.


Congratulations to the following students for placing 4<sup>th</sup> in the tournament:

## The Fine Arts Council meeting scheduled for today is postponed until Thursday due to a scheduling conflict.


# Attention Boys Ball Hockey team. There will be a short meeting at the start of Lunch in room 229.

# The library will be closed Thursday April 18 and Friday April 19 for the OSSLT. Students writing the OSSLT on those days should arrive before 8 am to get set up.


