#### Banting's Military Co-op

**Have you EVER thought about joining the Military??** Did you know you can join the military thru Banting's Co-op Program?

This is a Full-Time Co-op, offered during the 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester.

#### You would:

- Earn 4 High School Credits.
- Make \$14,000 under the Paid Co-op.
- Be given an option to continue working full-time for the remaining 2+ months of Summer earning an additional \$10,000
- Get all your military qualifications and be fully trained in your choice of occupation. \*Some restrictions.
- Remain in the Reserves (after Co-op) in a Part-time capacity and be offered full-time employment each summer.

There will be an information session on **April 30**<sup>th</sup> **During period 2.** 

Interested students should sign up in the co-op office or on class D2L if they would like to attend.








#### **Badminton**
